### **CABIN EQUESTRIAN'S FIRST BSJA SHOW A RESOUNDING SUCCESS**

THE Cabin Equestrian Centre, Inverurie, Aberdeenshire launched the first of its Senior BSJA shows on the evening of Tuesday, June 30 with a staggering 70 entries.

Featuring 90cm, one metre, 1.10m and 1m 20 first round National Amateur Qualifiers over an impressive course showcasing the recently purchased ex-Kingsbarn jumps, the competition attracted riders from as far afield as Moray and Kincardineshire with BSJA classes running from 6pm to 11pm. The Cabin's new 40m x 80m outdoor silica sand and rubber arena proved a huge hit with riders as did course building by Diane Beaumont.

Fiona Quennell, proprietor of The Cabin Equestrian Centre, commented: "Morgan and I were delighted with the support we received for our first BSJA competition from competitors and we look forward to seeing them all again at future events. We would happily receive any feedback - good or bad - to improve their experience here at The Cabin.

The Cabin Equestrian Centre's next fixture in its year round BSJA event calendar is a BSJA Intro show which will be held on Sunday, July 19 with a 70cm unaffiliated open, an 80cm open Regional Points Qualifier, first round one metre, National Amateur Qualifier and a one metre open.

Three BSJA competitions will run during the month of August – an Amateur show on Saturday August 1 with 90cm, 1m, 1.10m and 1.20m first round National Amateur Championship Qualifiers and a BSJA Progressive Show on Sunday August 2 featuring the KBIS Insurance Senior British Novice and Equissage Discovery Championships first rounds, 1.05 open, Tri Zone senior Newcomers first round and the 1.20m National Amateur Championship qualifier first round.

The third show - The Amateur BSJA show on Tuesday, August 18 - will feature 90cm, one metre, 1.10m and 1m 20 first round National Amateur Qualifiers. Free tickets to ride will be available at selected shows.

The Cabin Equestrian Centre is currently underway with stage two of its development with work starting on a 67m x 30m indoor arena complete with Turfloat surface, viewing gallery and café area.
