### **BEST BRITISH SHOWJUMPING SHOW AT THE CABIN EC**

ENTRIES once again topped 200 at The Cabin Equestrian Centre's two day British Showjumping show on the weekend of June 19 and 20.

With the main arena action now in the outdoor arena for the summer months, riders turned out in force from all over Scotland with competitors from Ayrshire to Moray and 26 horses bed and breakfasting. The most popular class both days was Newcomers/1.10m with the earlier classes equally well filled. This was despite a busy weekend for equestrian events with both Burgie International Horse Trials on at Forres and second rounds at Rowallan.

And for local rider Lesley Ross it proved an extra special weekend with her winning her first 1.05m class on Could Be Lucky. Likewise, Aberdeenshire based Scott Sinclair also enjoyed a successful two days on "Cool" winning the 1.05m Open on Saturday and the 95cm Open on Sunday. Sara Gibb also was in the ribbons both days with first place in the 1.20m Horse and Hound Foxhunter on Sunday with Tweedwizard M, having won second place in Saturday's Foxhunter class on her other ride Wot Not. Wot Not and Sara also went on to win Saturday's 1.25m Open.

Fiona Quennell, proprietor of The Cabin EC commented: "We were delighted with the level of entries we had as there was so much on that weekend – in general, there's a lot on at this time of year. It was an excellent two days of jumping and there was a great atmosphere throughout the weekend.

"Everyone enjoyed getting outside and having the classes there and the warm-up in doors – it made you believe that summer is finally here! We also had several compliments about Diane Beaumont's course design which is really positive."

The month of July sees an evening British Showjumping show on Tuesday, July 6 followed by three days of British Showjumping at the Centre on July 30, 31 and August 1. Pony classes will be included in Friday's schedule and both Saturday and

Sunday will include adult Scottish HOYS Qualifiers. August British Showjumping dates are August 1, 15 and 24.
