### **BSJA ENTRIES SOAR AT THE CABIN EC**

SUNDAY (October 4) saw a total of 106 entries to The Cabin Equestrian Centre's BSJA Intro Show, the highest number at the Centre to date. Competitors – including new members and those now renewing their BSJA membership - came from as far afield as Dundee to the south and Brodie to the north.

The main action of the day took place in the outdoor arena with warm-up in the new 67m x 30m silica sand and fibres indoor arena. This latest phase completion sees The Cabin Equestrian Centre as the largest combined equestrian facility in the North East of Scotland.

Fiona Quennell, proprietor of The Cabin Equestrian Centre, commented: "We were delighted with the number of entries on Sunday. The support and feedback has been tremendous.

"As it was such a sunny day, we decided to hold the classes outside and the warm-up indoors and the new indoor facility received great feedback from the riders.

"We're very excited about the new indoor facilities as it provides so much opportunity here at The Cabin. All our shows will now be indoors for winter – both weekend and mid-week – and it will be available for hire on Sundays."

The next date in The Cabin's year round calendar of equestrian dates is a BSJA Progressive Show on Tuesday, October 20 with first rounds for the KBIS Insurance Senior British Novice Championship, Equissage Discovery Championship, one metre National Amateur Championship Qualifier and Tri-Zone Senior Newcomers/1.10m Open.

The fortnightly Wednesday evening winter leagues will commence October 21 with showjumping and dressage on October 28. Top showjumping instructor Andrew Hamilton will be at The Cabin on October 13 and 14.
