JUNIOR BSJA CLASSES LAUNCHED AT THE CABIN EC

JUNIOR BSJA is being launched at The Cabin Equestrian Centre, Keithhall, Inverurie in the Sunday, November 15 Ponies and Senior Intro British Showjumping Show. Two classes for juniors are included in the schedule - class one, a Pony 70cm Open and class two, a 80cm Open, both Regional Points Qualifiers.

The remaining classes on November 15 will be for Seniors with a 70cm unaffiliated open, an 80cm open, 90cm national Amateur Championship Qualifier first round, one metre National Amateur Championship Qualifier first round and a one metre Open.

Fiona Quennell, proprietor of The Cabin Equestrian Centre, explained the decision: "We have been asked about running pony classes by a lot of people so we have decided to trial it and include two classes for juniors in this Intro Show. We're hoping that it will be very well supported as we aim to give riders what they are looking for."

Despite a week of freak flooding and wintry weather, competitors still turned out in force to support the recent BSJA shows at The Cabin Equestrian Centre, Keithhall, Inverurie. Sunday, October 25 and Tuesday, October 20 saw The Cabin running two BSJA Progressive Shows. The new indoor arena played host to the event with the new holding area within the school proving popular with riders seeking shelter from the elements! Fiona added: "We couldn't believe the number of entries considering how awful the weather was. We really appreciated everyone's support."

The year round calendar of senior BSJA continues to roll at The Cabin EC with an Adult BSJA Show on Tuesday, November 24 and a provisional date for a further BSJA show on December 27.
