TWO DAY BSJA HAS RECORD ENTRIES AT THE CABIN

THE weekend of September 5 and 6 saw record entries at The Cabin Equestrian Centre two day BSJA show. Entries at Sunday's (September 6) Progressive/Advanced Show topped well over 100 with Saturday (September 5) not far behind.

This marks the highest number of entries for a BSJA competition at the new Cabin Equestrian Centre and, coupled with first class feedback from riders and spectators, looks set to put The Cabin EC firmly on the map as one of Scotland's top showjumping hot spots.

Fiona Quennell, proprietor of The Cabin Equestrian Centre, commented:"Entries have just continued to grow at each BSJA show we have held here and this two day show was no exception.

"I am delighted with all the positive feedback that has come forward and the riders' enthusiasm for the venue, surface and course building is quite overwhelming.

"However, I have taken decided to put all shows on hold until Sunday, October 4 when the new indoor arena will be completed. We apologise for any convenience caused and look forward to seeing riders next month."

The next date in The Cabin's year round calendar of equestrian dates is a BSJA Intro Show on Sunday, October 4 with classes including a 70cm unaffiliated open, 80cm and one metre opens plus 90cm and one metre National Amateur Championship Qualifier first rounds. Free Tickets to Ride will be available. This will be followed by a BSJA Progressive Show on Tuesday, October 20 with first rounds for the KBIS Insurance Senior British Novice Championship, Equissage Discovery Championship, one metre National Amateur Championship Qualifier and Tri-Zone Senior Newcomers.

Work is well underway at The Cabin Equestrian Centre on stage two of its development – a 67m x 30m indoor arena complete with Turfloat surface, viewing gallery and café area.
