## Mini-Major Show Jumping Competition

**6<sup>th</sup> January 2019 – 10am**

Class 1: **x-poles / 40cm(can be assisted)**

Class 2: **50cm**

Class 3: **60cm**

**Mini-Major for Classes 1-3. Class 4 will not start before 1pm**

Class 4: **70cm**

Class 5: **80cm**

Class 6: **90cm**



**Mini-Major for Classes 4-5**

**To be eligible to compete in the mini-major classes – competitors must be aged under 25 as this is age restriction for Ponyclub membership**

**The top three placed in each class will then compete in the mini -major event – their jumps will not exceed the maximum height of their qualifying class, there will be no more than 6 jumps for the mini and the major rider. The majors will complete 6 jumps at 1m height (maximum). The winning combination of each class (that is the quickest pair) will receive a rosette**

### Entry Fees

**Ponyclub Members: £10 per round (maximum 2 rounds)**

**Non-members: £12 per round (maximum 2 rounds)**

**Entries to be in by Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> December 2018 – no entries on the day**

**Times available 04/01/2019 on East Aberdeenshire Ponyclub website.**

## Show Jumping Rules

- Each competitor can complete a maximum of 2 rounds of jumping, excluding The Finale if placed.
- For each Class that is the maximum height jumps will be set at on the course
- Rosettes for individuals 1-6<sup>th</sup> and those placed 1-3<sup>rd</sup> will go forward to the MINI-MAJOR. Prize giving will be after the completion of each class.
- The MINI-MAJOR finale will be at the end of class for classes 1-3 and then at the end of class 6 following classes 4-6
- The Majors will be randomly drawn to compete with finalists from a class.
- Rosettes will be awarded to the winning mini and major for each class.
- The Judge's decision is final.
- Classes run under The Pony Club rules, the full 2018 Rulebook is available free of charge to download online. Please make sure you adhere to tack and dress rules. All hats must meet current Pony Club Standards.
- The wearing of body protectors is recommended for Adults and Children
- The making of an entry implies acceptance of the conditions listed above
